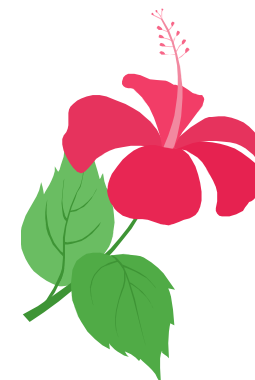
Welcome to Moringa!
